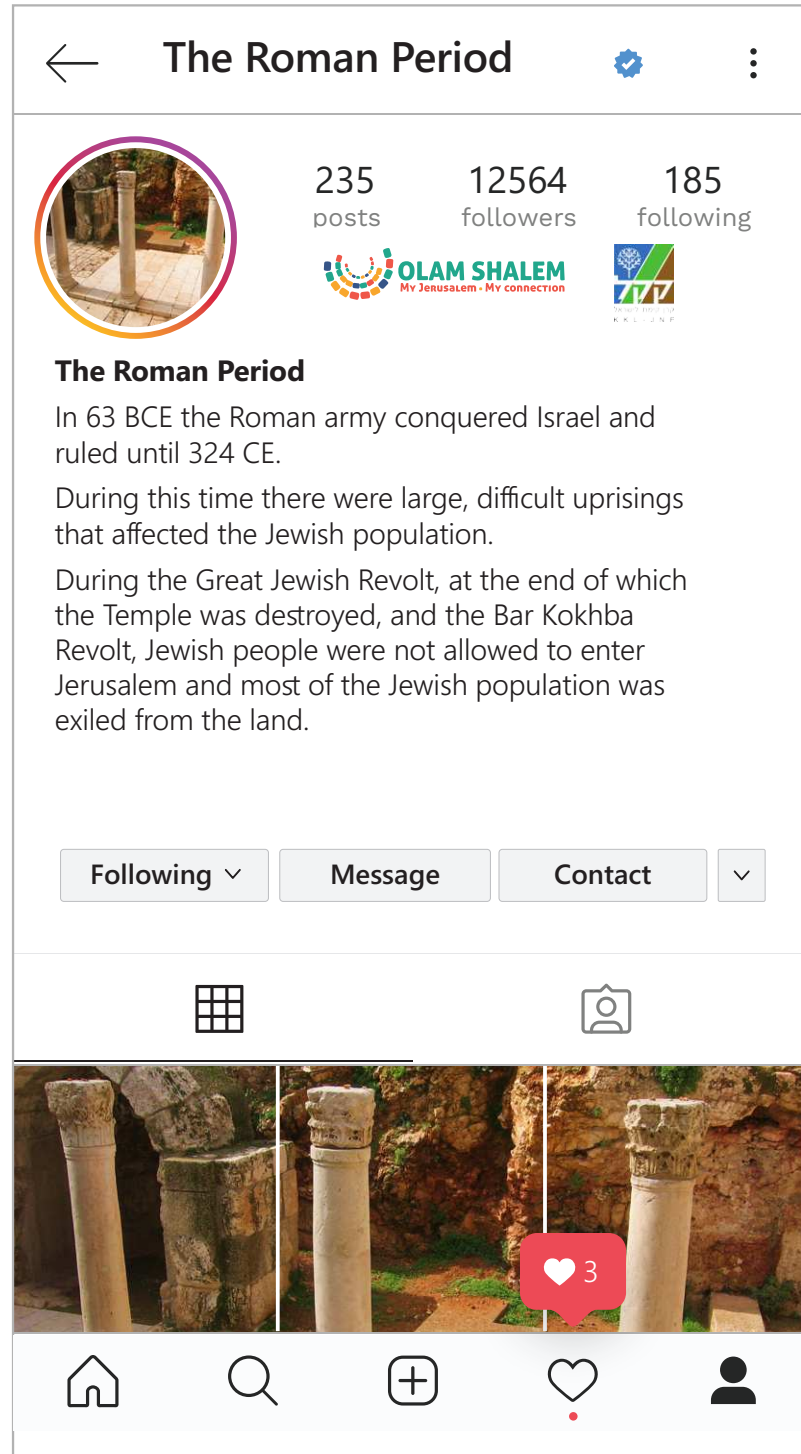




Independent, Jewish rulers who were Jewish kings and priests.

**The Roman Period**

In 63 BCE the Roman army conquered Israel and ruled until 324 CE.

During this time there were large, difficult uprisings that affected the Jewish population.

During the Great Jewish Revolt, at the end of which the Temple was destroyed, and the Bar Kokhba Revolt, Jewish people were not allowed to enter Jerusalem and most of the Jewish population was exiled from the land.

### Ottoman Empire

Ruled for 400 years in Israel (1516-1917).

At its peak sprawled from south-east Europe to North Africa.

During their rule, they reached Jerusalem and the city developed from a remote city to a part of the western world, with consulates operating in the city in the last period of the Empire.

From the middle of the nineteenth century, there was a large influx of Jews to Jerusalem and the population of the Jewish city tripled itself.
